

School Mission Statement

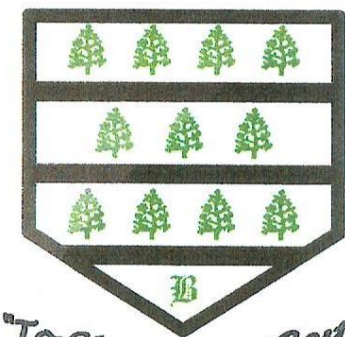
