

BARLOWS PRIMARY SCHOOL

Admission to Nursery Procedures

Barlows Primary School has its own Nursery Application Form which was designed to collate information required by the SIMS System.

- Parents have a preference to select either an A.M. or P.M. Session.
- Forms are completed following a child's first birthday.
- Forms are filed for each cohort using the D.O.B. Age Range.
- Forms are filed in Date of Application Order.
- Parents/Carers are informed by letter in the Spring Term prior to their child starting Nursery.
- The letter details the allocated session, the open day date and start date; it also gives information about the Nursery uniform.

Barlows Nursery has two classes of 30 children (60 in total)

Nursery Places are allocated using the following criteria:-

- Priority 1 SEN/LAC Children
- Priority 2 Siblings
- Priority 3 Children who attend Fazakerley Children's Centre
- Priority 4 Date of Application Order

Names of unsuccessful applicants are kept on file in the event of a child withdrawing from the Nursery. The place is then re-offered to a child on the waiting list.

Parents/Carers are informed on the Application Form and in the Nursery Place officer that admission to the Nursery Class does not guarantee their child a place in the Reception Class.

Admission to Reception Procedures

Reception Class places are allocated by the LA.

- A Primary Admissions leaflet is produced by the LA for distribution in the Autumn Term before the child is due to start the Reception Year.
- Children attending Barlows Nursery are given a copy of the Primary Admission leaflet which strongly advises parents to apply on line.
- Additional copies are kept in the School Office for children who do not attend the Nursery.
- Parents/Carers complete the application form on line.
- Parents/Carers have the option to ask for support from school or Fazakerley Childrens' Centre to apply on-line.
- Parents/Carers state their three preferences of Primary School.

The LA allocates Reception Class places using the following criteria:-

- Priority 1 SEN/LAC Children
- Priority 2 Siblings
- Priority 3 Distance from School
- The LA informs the school of our allocated children at the end of the Spring Term.
- Parents are informed by the LA which school has been allocated to their child.
- The LA does provide an appeal procedure if necessary.
- Barlows Primary School sends a welcoming letter with details of the 'New Reception Class Meeting' which is held in the Summer Term.
