PARENT GOVERNOR VACANCIES

During the last academic year, the term of office for our two parent governors came to an end. As a result of their terms ending, we now have two vacancies for parent governors.

What is a school governor?

School governors are volunteers who help to **run** the school. Most schools work with a group of school governors - together they are called the **'governing body**'. They are involved in decisions about all aspects of managing the school – such as running buildings and budgets, supporting staff and setting standards. Governors also help to make big decisions about the school's long-term goals. They support the Headteacher, but also ask questions and make sure the Headteacher is taking the school in the right direction.

The most important qualities for being a governor are **enthusiasm, commitment** and an **interest in education**. You do not need teaching experience, but it is useful to bring skills from other areas of your life.

You will need to attend two to three meetings every term. These usually take place after school at 4.30pm. There a few days per year when governors spend the day in school seeing how things run first hand.

Becoming a parent governor is a great way to help develop and support the school whilst ensuring the parent voice is well represented.

During the week commencing Monday 17th September, a letter will be going out explaining the process involved for parents and carers nominating themselves to become a Parent Governor. I hope to be working with some of you in the near future!
