Communication and Language

This week's theme is the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle. If you have the story at home already that's great, if not don't worry use the link to watch the story on YouTube.



Can your child follow the story of the very hungry caterpillar? Can they remember the order of the different foods the caterpillar eats?

Literacy

Rhyming is important to help your child learn to read. Can your child hear rhyming words? Can they continue a rhyming string? If you say: cat, rat, Can they give another rhyming word e.g. bat?



Alphablocks: Rhyming Words

Can children hear the initial sound in those words, c cat, r rat, b bat? If your child is ready to do so can they write that initial letter and form it correctly?

Mathematics

Finding 1 more or 1 less

Can your child find one more or one less from a group of up to five objects, then ten objects? You could use toys, lego pieces or cutlery to help them count.

Phase 1 phonics is important to help children with general sound discrimination and supports children's understanding of why listening is important.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Different places and settings have different behavioural expectations. Can your child tell you about the expectations 'rules' in school? Can they then discuss the behavioural expectations at home 'rules'. Are any of the expectations the same, or different?

Understanding the world

To understand and observe the life cycle of a butterfly.

- 1. A butterfly lays eggs
- 2. Eggs hatch into caterpillars
- 3. Caterpillar grows
- 4. The caterpillar makes a cocoon
- 5. Caterpillar turns into a butterfly



Watch the clip and talk about the different stages.

Expressive arts and design

To create and experiment with different textures to make a butterfly picture. Can you find objects around your house to make your own butterfly, paints, cotton wool, pasta, coloured paper, tissue paper, glitter?

Can your child make the butterfly symmetrical the same on each wing?
