Counting in Twos

Watch the clip to practise counting in 2's.

Use your number cards to create the pattern of counting in 2's. Lay your number cards in order and turn over every other number 1, 3, 5 etc. The numbers left facing up will be counting in 2's. Ask a grown up or older sibling to check for you. Point to each number facing up and practise counting in 2's to 20 and then 30.

Britain in Spring Time: BBC Teach

Watch the clip about signs of spring. Look out the window or if you can, go for a walk with a grown up and look out for signs of spring near your home. Can you spot some signs of spring? Can you describe the difference between the season winter and spring?

During spring, lots of animals have their babies. Find out the names of these baby animals: duck, pig, sheep, cow and horse.

Expressive arts and design



Melody and the Butterfly Ball

Watch this clip from Melody on CBeebies. Listen to the music – which instrument can you hear playing the main melody? Can you dance/move like a Butterfly?

During spring seeds begin to grow. In the story of Jack and the Beanstalk, Jack's beans grow into a magic beanstalk. Can you talk through the story of Jack and the Beanstalk with a grown up at home. You could even act out the story together.
