Answer the questions on page 11.  </p> <p style="text-align: center;">"Wizard of Oz- Chapter 2" – Writing Activity</p> <p>In chapter two, Dorothy arrives in Munchkin Land. This land is very different from Kansas, this is where Dorothy is from. Use page 13 from the document to plan how Kansas is different to the land of the Munchkins. Then write descriptive paragraphs explaining how the two places are very different.
