# How to plant a sunflower

## You will need...

A pot

Soil

Two sunflower seeds

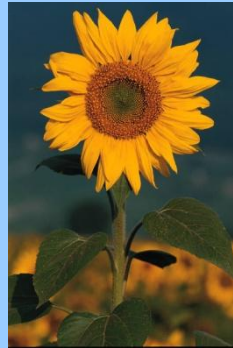
A watering can



## Method (how to make) :

1. First, fill the pot nearly to the top with some soil.
2. Using the watering can, dampen the soil with a little water.
3. Now place two sunflower seeds onto the soil.
4. Next, cover the seeds with some more soil.
5. Finally, pour a little more water onto the soil.

Remember to water your sunflower once a day to help it grow! You will start to see the sunflower growing within two or three weeks.



# Pepperoni Pizza

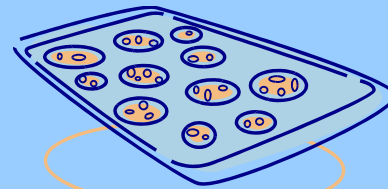
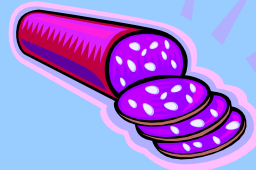
## Ingredients:

Pizza Base

Tomato sauce

Grated cheese

Pepperoni



## Instructions

1. Wash your hands.
2. Spread tomato sauce on pizza base with a spoon.
3. Sprinkle cheese on top.
4. Then put pepperoni on top.
5. Put on tray and cook in the oven. Cook for 8 minutes on 200°C.
6. Eat your pizza.
