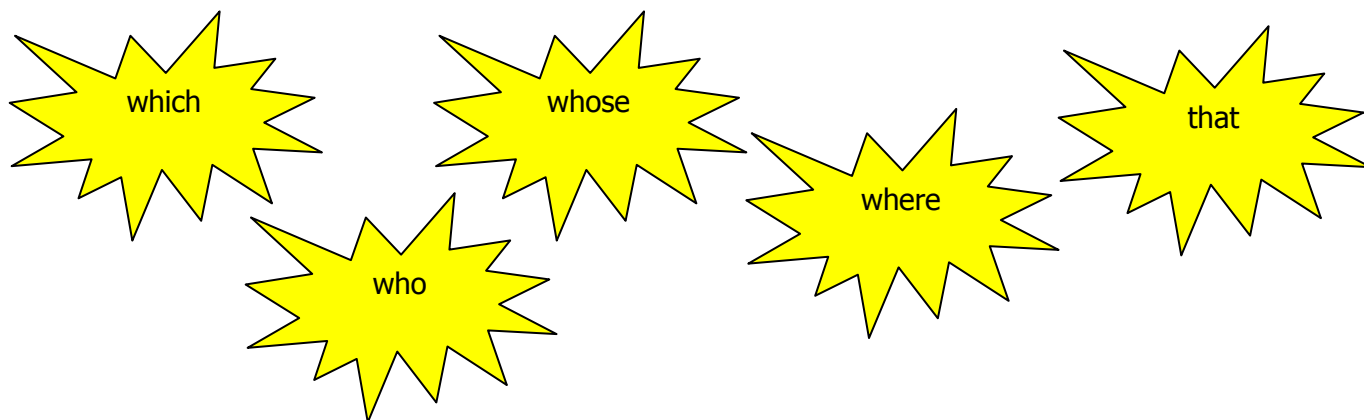


Relative Clauses
