Open the doors! It's the Go-Givers. We've come to help them!

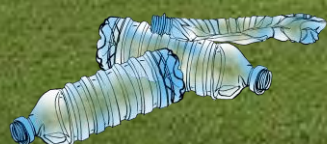
What weird creatures. They're not at all like you described!

returning.**



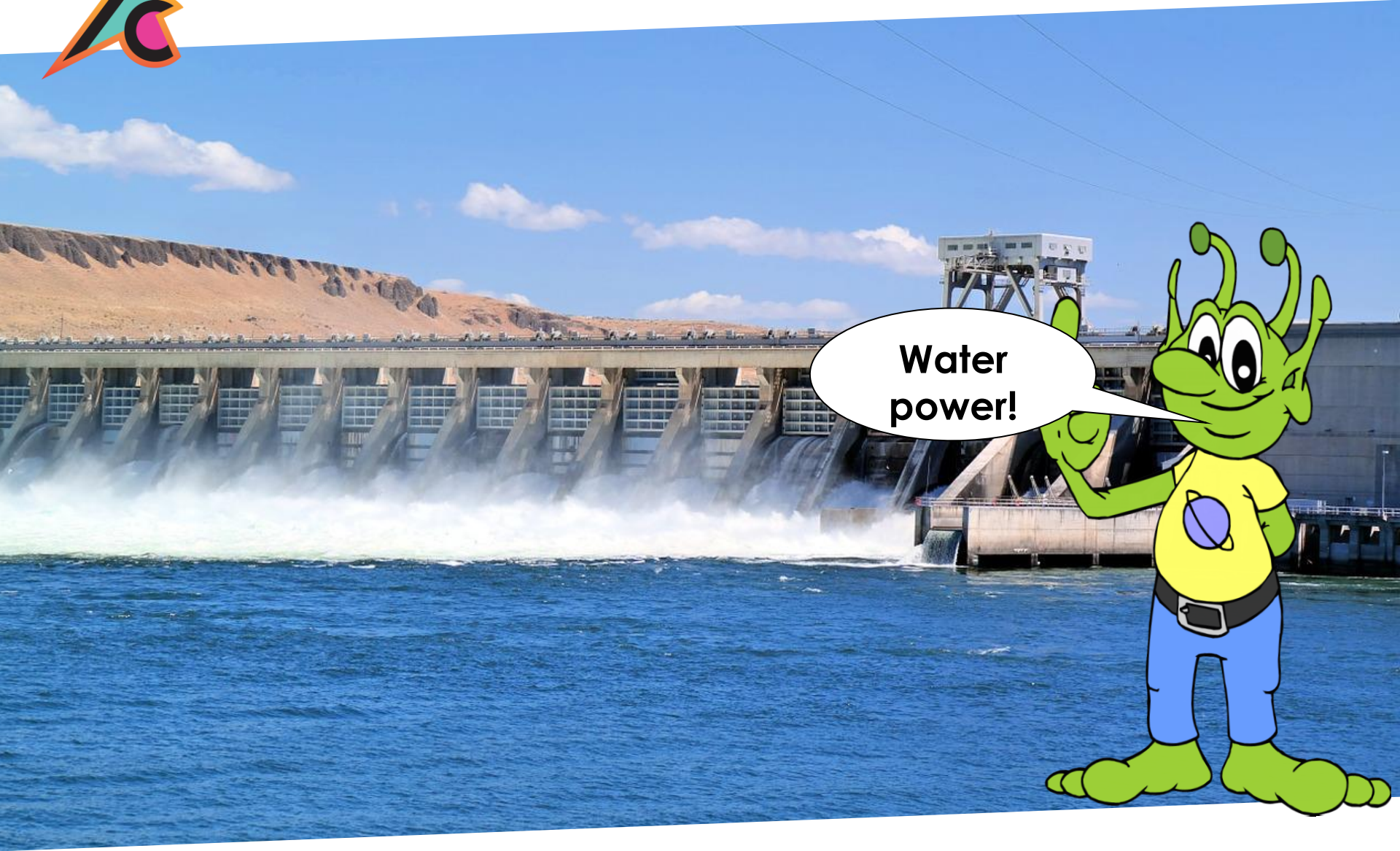

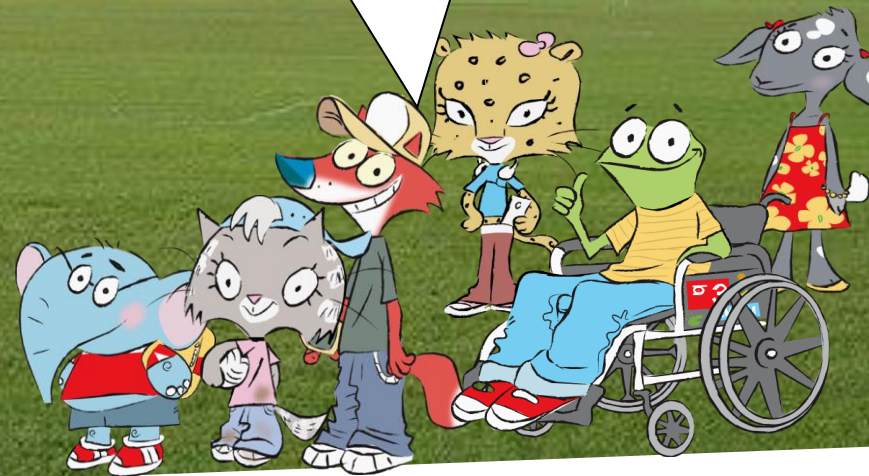

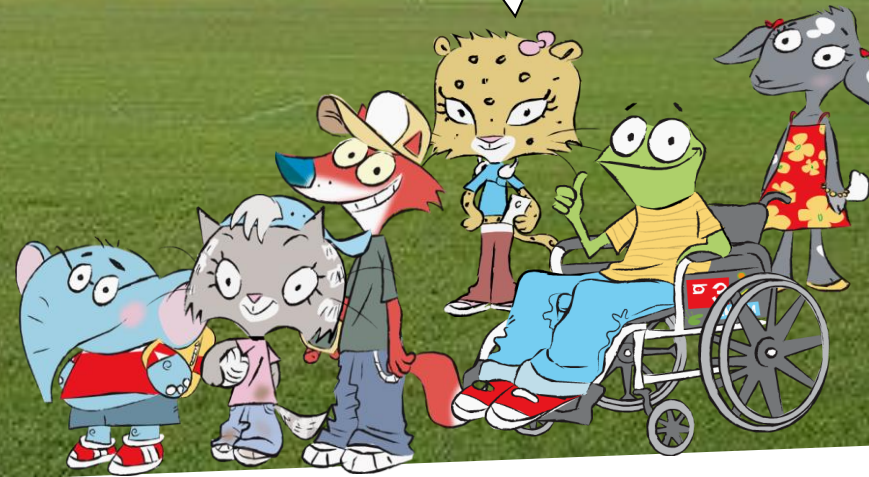
