









Expedition to Planet Blue Ball

And they put fuel in the top of their bodies every few hours!




















Many creatures on Planet Blue Ball live in the forests. Some species are dying where the forests have been destroyed.















Some Uebals don't care about the countryside. They leave litter wherever they go.










































