<p>Jack and the beanstalk </p> <p>Listen to this story of Jack and the Beanstalk, can you help your child to retell the story in their own words. What happened at the beginning, middle and end? What was your favourite part of the story?</p> <p>Can you practise and learn the Jack and the Beanstalk songs and rhymes. Use the additional documents (Jack's Giant Song, Climbing up the Beanstalk) on the Nursery Home Learning Page wc 29.06.20 for ideas.</p>	<p>Name Writing </p> <p>Please continue name writing this will really support your child when starting Reception (first name and surname).</p> <p>Mary, Mary, Quite Contrary </p> <p>Follow the link to learn the nursery rhyme 'Mary, Mary, Quite Contrary'. Can your child find all of the rhyming words? Can you help and encourage your child to change the rhyming words to make a new rhyme, e.g. instead of "Silver bells and cockle shells," it could be "orange pigs in purple wigs and silly cats all in a row."</p>	<p>Ordering Numbers and Counting </p> <p>Can you collect a selection of different seeds? These seeds can be used for a variety of counting, addition and subtraction activities, as well as for sorting and categorising. *Can you count out 5 seeds? *Can you make 2 groups of seeds, which group has more/less? *If we have 4 seeds and take 2 away, how many are left? *If we have 5 seeds and add 2 more, how many are left? Practise identifying and writing numbers to 10. Follow the link and use the number rhymes to help with your formation. </p>

Use these to make a collage garden and talk about what features you might like to have in a garden. What would make the perfect garden? Encourage children to use their imaginations to create their own perfect garden. What would they like or dislike in their garden?</p>

Use Monet's paintings of gardens as a stimulus for creative work. Use sponges to paint impressionist-style paintings. Use the additional document (Monet Garden Photos) on the Nursery Home Learning Page wc 29.06.20 for ideas.</p>

<p>Plants we eat Talk about the difference between the seeds we can eat and the seeds we can't. Can you name the seeds in plants that we can eat? Use the additional document (Plants we eat) on the Nursery Home Learning Page wc 29.06.20 for ideas.</p>	<p>Importance of bees </p> <p>Explain to the children the importance of bees and butterflies in pollinating plants and encourage them to look out for these insects and observe them carefully if they see them in the outdoor area.</p>	<p>Listening and attention game Play a listening and attention game with the children. Place a number of different coloured flowers on a tray and cover with a blanket. Remove one of the flowers. Can the children say which one has been removed? What did it look like? Can they remember the name of that type of flower?</p>
