


Facility of the European Union

Smartie was allowed to play on his tablet once in the morning and once in the afternoon.


Mummy Penguin helped Smartie to get online and he was off!




Smartie was on his tablet playing his favourite game, Snowcraft. He was getting better and better.



All of a sudden, the tablet beeped, and a message appeared on the screen. Another player was trying to talk to Smartie. Smartie felt quite excited.






The other player continued to talk. "Where do you live?" she asked. Smartie wanted to reply because he wanted to be friendly. But he was also beginning to feel worried.

"Oh Smartie, you are so SENSIBLE," said 6 Daddy Penguin.


"The other player was asking for your personal information. You must keep your personal information safe online and never share it with anyone."
