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## Reading and Writing

**Reading** Read the poem "Fish in a dish" by Ros Letellier. See additional Fish in a Dish Poem document on the Y2 learning at home page WC 08.06.20.

- What did you think of the poem?
- What features can you identify?
- What do you notice about the poem? (*repeated words/sounds, tongue twister?*).
- Which words have the same sound? (fish/dish). Which have the same vowel sound? (oodles/noodles). Which rhyme? (mussels/Brussels; wish/fish/dish/)

### Writing

Paraphrase the poem line by line. (*She wants a dish of mashed potato and fish. She wants lots of noodles*). Read it back. *Is it still funny? Which version is better?* Create a list of tongue-twister features (e.g. repeated words, alliteration, repeated vowel sounds, rhyme) and use this to write your own poem using the same pattern as "Fish in a Dish". There is an example of this activity in the home learning section entitled "Dog with a Log".
