Reading and Writing

Reading – Please click on the link and log into Wordsmith Active Learn to find two documents allocated for you to read: A Fish in a Dish and Tongue Twisters. Use the login details emailed to your parents via

Parent Mail. After reading the poems, please watch the video of 'Fox in Socks' by Dr Seuss. Try to pick out the rhyming words used in the story. Look at the rhyming structure. Have a go at reading it yourself, focusing primarily on the first page. Is it difficult? Why? Look at how

the author uses short sentences and quick rhymes. How do you know that Mr Knox finds it difficult? What does he say? Practise saying it yourself to see how quick vour tongue is!

Writing - Make a short list of rhyming words in pairs (eg. goat, boat; floor, door; rice, mice). Can you use the words to create your own tongue twister poem in the style of Dr Seuss? See additional Y2 Example of Poem, Y2 Guidance for writing task and Y2 bank of rhyming words documents on the Y2 learning at home page WC 15.06.20. Extension: Record yourself performing your poem (maybe add music to make it into a rap like in the YouTube video). Don't forget to perform and make your rhyme fun and interesting!
