Visual Impairment

Helen Keller was a famous writer in the late 1800s/early 1900s. She was both deaf and blind, as the result of an illness she had when she was a child. She learned how to communicate through finger spelling with her teacher, Anne Sullivan, and learned how to read using Braille.
