Apostrophes

When and when not to use them.

Apostrophes can be used to show missing letters.

I cannot come to the party.

I can't come to the party.

Cannot becomes can't.

The apostrophe shows that there are letters missing.

More examples of apostrophes for contraction.

Jack would not play with his baby brother.

Jack wouldn't play with his baby brother.

Emma did not want to eat the unhealthy chocolate cake.

Emma *didn't* want to eat the unhealthy chocolate cake.

What do these words become when you shorten them?

have not haven't

they will they'll

shall not shan't

I have I've

you are you're
