<p><b>Under the Sea</b> Talk about the seaside, asking questions such as: Have you been to the seaside? What can you do at the seaside? Did you see any sea creatures? Have you been to a sea life centre? What creatures did you see? If you went under sea, what would we need? <b>E.g. diving gear, oxygen tanks etc.</b></p> <p>Talk about related vocabulary including <b>ocean, waves, sea creatures, the names of sea creatures and seaweed.</b> Talk to your child about their understanding of each of these words.</p>		<p><b>Name Writing</b> Practise name writing this will really support your child when starting Reception.</p> <p><b>The Rainbow Fish</b> Read the story 'The Rainbow Fish'. Can your child name any other sea creatures and plants they see in the story? After reading the story, ask your child to use their knowledge of the story to sequence the events using these Story Sequencing Cards. <b>Can your child talk through the events that happen on each sequence card?</b> Use the additional document (<b>Story sequence cards</b>) on the Nursery Home Learning Page wc 6.07.20.</p>	<p><b>Ordering Numbers and Counting</b></p> <p>Using a selection of pebbles, stones or shells to make groups of sea items from 1-10. Can you sequence the objects by size, starting with the smallest to the biggest? Use the additional document (<b>Ordering by size</b>) on the Nursery Home Learning Page wc 6.07.20. Can you start at 0 and write the numbers you know in order. Use the number rhymes to help with your formation, for example <b>down and across and a little bit more, that's the way we make a 4.</b></p>

<p><b>Blending and Segmenting</b> Continue to practise your oral blending and segmenting to support your child when starting Reception.</p> <p><b>Five Little Fishes:</b> Sing the Five Little Fishes Song with your child. Talk about different percussion instruments and how they can represent different sea creatures. Encourage the children to think about which instrument would be best and why.</p>		<p><b>PE with Beth Tweedle</b> Take part in Week 9's 'Inspiration' themed PE pack from gymnastics provider, Beth Tweedle Gymnastics.</p> <p><b>Dance with Oti Mabuse</b> Learn a new dance based on a children's film with Oti Mabuse each day at 11:30am</p>	<p><b>Friendship Stories</b></p> <p>Using the story 'The Rainbow Fish'. Discuss how the rainbow fish behaved. How might the other fish have felt? How might the Rainbow Fish have felt once he began to share his scales?</p> <p>Using the story 'The Snail and the Whale' discuss how and why the snail was able to help the whale?</p>
