Can you name the animals on the boat? Where might they be going?
After Mr Gumpy has been introduced, what can you tell about him from the picture?
New vocabulary to discuss while reading; What does it mean to **squabble** or **trample**?
Try to use these words in different contexts and encourage your child to use these words within sentences they create themselves.

Writing Activity

Draw Mr Gumpy's journey down the river as a story map. Try to remember each character he lets on the boat. Use your map to practise retelling the story. Use the additional document (**Story Map examples and Character Cut outs**) on the Reception Home learning page wc 06.07.20.

One more and one less



Use your number cards to help you practise finding one more or one less. Lay your cards out in order from 1 to 30.
Ask your child to make one jump with their finger for one more and one jump backwards with their finger to find one less than the given number.

Traffic survey

Can you carry out a traffic survey and talk about the different types of transport you see from your house or on a daily walk? Can you tally how many different types of traffic you see? e.g. 6 buses etc? Transport cleaning

Can you help a grown up or family member to clean a vehicle? If you have a bike or scooter maybe you could clean that.
You might want to clean your toy cars. As you clean, talk about the wheels, lights, tyres, windows etc. Can your child identify different parts on the vehicle?
