



## A root word ending in a consonant


To add -ed, -er and - Cried est:

Change the y to an i.

To add -ing:

Keep the -y.

crying



## A word ending in a consonant then -e

To add -ed, -ing, -er, -est and -y (or any other suffix beginning with a vowel letter):

Drop the -e.

smile d



# A one syllable word ending in a single vowel then a single


To add -edoing er and est:

Double the last consonant.

poppe d

#### **Except:**

The letter 'x' which is never doubled and the letter 'c', instead of doubling it, add
