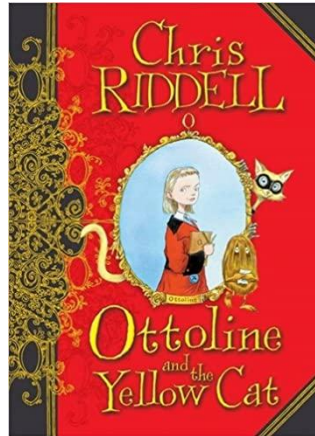

Writing Activity – Planning a sequel



Before you begin your writing task ensure you have read to the end of chapter 10, even if you have not completed your comprehension questions yet. By this point you will have come to the end of the story and will be able to see how accurate the prediction you made last week about the ending was.

Think about the story as a whole, the characters that Chris Riddell created and the style in which he wrote. The whole story will be available for you to read online again if you wish to refer back to any part.

We would like you to plan a sequel to the story. Use the planning template (See Year 3 Writing planning template in the Y3 Home Learning Section wc 13 07 20) to help you decide on some of the key details of your writing. Certain elements will remain the same, your story should still feature Ottoline and Mr Munroe as the leading characters and you may chose to keep the location of the Pepperpot Building in your story as well. You will need to create a new 'mystery' for them to solve and as a result this will probably require new characters who will feature as part of this.

When you have completed your plan, have a go at writing at least the opening chapter. Think about how to set the scene and re-introduce your main characters (remember not all readers will have read the original story). Try to keep to the styling of Ottoline and the Yellow Cat, this may mean adding postcards or annotated drawings if necessary. Only include these if they actually enhance the story though, don't be tempted to put them in just because the first book had them.

You have the option to complete some more or all of the sequel throughout the summer if you wish.
