Growing Together as a Family The project continues

We have been lucky enough to be one of only 2 schools in Liverpool to be selected to host a prestigious Art Project supporting mental health of families in our community. 
Easter Raffle - Friday 04/04/25 Tickets on sale wc 31/03/25

Melanie is a blind swimmer with an outstanding career in competitive sports. She's represented Great Britain at multiple Paralympic Games, winning gold, silver and bronze medals in the pool – and winning multiple European and World titles. But she didn't stop there! Last year, Melanie made history as the first blind woman to swim the English Channel, conquering 21 miles of open water in an astounding 12 hours and 20 minutes.

Year 1 & Year 2 Monday 10/03/2025 'Change Champions'


As part of the British Science Week, our pupils will take part in an online session from the National Farmers' Union, where they will be joined Lamia, Ruby and Dr Lutfi Radwan on their farm to meet their animals – including chickens, goats and sheep – and learn how farming can help tackle climate change, support biodiversity and reduce waste.

Year 3 & Year 4 Wednesday 12/03/2025 'Amazing Adaptations'

As part of the British Science Week, our pupils will take part in an online session from the National Farmers' Union, where they will learn why AHDB lead animal genetics expert Dr Harriet Bunning's cows are so important for the local ecosystem, go on a soil safari with Dr Samuel Eze from Harper Adams University and learn from flower grower and florist Roisin Taylor about climate-friendly flower farming.

Year 5 & Year 6 Wednesday 12/03/2025 'Amazing Adaptations'

As part of the British Science Week, our pupils will take part in an online session from the National Farmers' Union, where they will explore selective breeding and genetic adaptations in livestock and crops, comparing Dr Harriet Bunning's cows to Zebu cattle from Sparsholt College, hear from researcher Emma Dods on how the Breed for Ch4nge project is selectively breeding climateresilient sheep, and listen to plant physiologist Claudia Carvalho explain how plant breeding helps create climateresistant crops.




Scholastic Book Fair
